

Minersville Walking Path

Minersville

BACKGROUND: In 1979, the Minersville Lions Club built a picnic pavilion adjacent to the community swimming pool and recreation area in the Borough of Minersville. The walking path was built at the recreation area in the 1990s by the Borough of Minersville in order to enhance the health and wellness of the town's citizens.



INFORMATION: There are three paths that are paved asphalt and fairly easy to walk although they are not pet or bicycle friendly. The path around the outside of the recreation complex is 1/2 mile in

length with two inside paths that range from 1/8 mile to 1/16 mile. The paths are maintained by Minersville Borough. Restrooms are available at the nearby Little League field during games and parking is available at the Minersville Recreation Parking Lot.

AREA ATTRACTIONS: The Minersville Area Community Pool and Little League Field are adjacent to the Walking Path. Main Street Sandwich Shop and The Coal Cracker Creamery are right down the street and several restaurants, grocery stores, and gas stations are located in or near the borough. Big Diamond Raceway, in nearby Forestville, holds weekly dirt track auto racing during the summer months.



EVENTS: Food, entertainment, and crafts are available at Minersville Spirit Day in September.
