

Gen. George Joulwan East Side Park

Pottsville

BACKGROUND: The park is named in honor of General George Joulwan, United States Army (Ret.), a native of Pottsville. General Joulwan received many decorations and awards during his military career and held the position of Supreme Allied Commander, Europe (NATO) from 1993 to 1997.

INFORMATION: Joulwan Park is located on the site of the former East Side swimming pool on East Norwegian Street in Pottsville. The pool, closed and neglected for several years, was demolished and replaced with a skate park, basketball courts and playground. There is also a beautiful memorial located at the



entrance to the park and an amphitheater. The park is broken up into 3 tiers because the area formerly contained a small reservoir. The walking trail is about 1/3 of a mile in length and the surface varies from stone to grass and asphalt.
